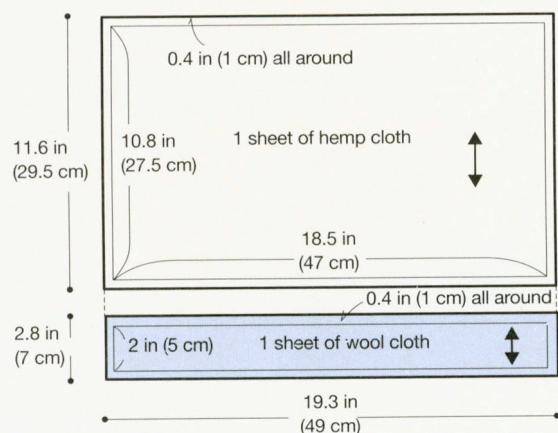
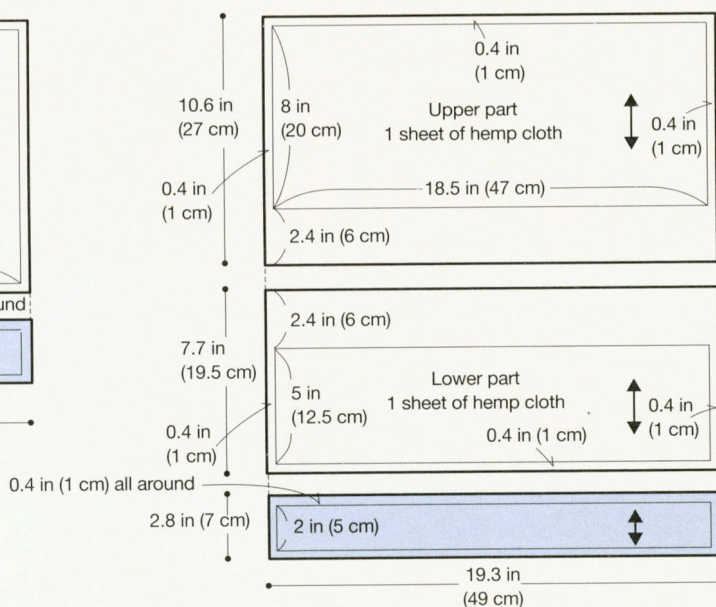

● Front side

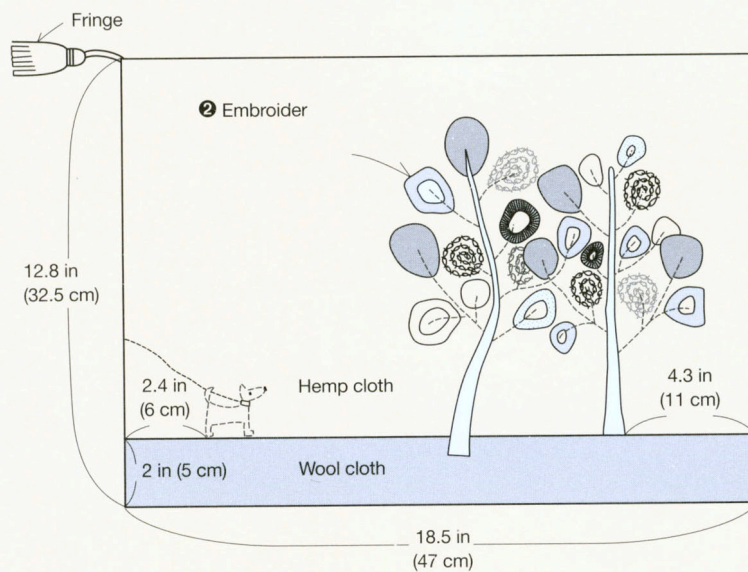


● Rear side

Front side



Hemp cloth (Front side)

① Sew the hemp and wool cloth, right sides facing, and open the seam

0.4 in (1 cm)

Wool cloth (Front side)

⑤ TW 8166, Make a fringe with thread

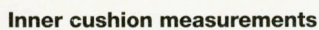
